#### **Principal's Report**

#### The countdown toward the end of year is on.

In the remaining few weeks, we have an incredible amount of work to complete, inside and outside the classroom, as end of year requirements are fulfilled and planning for 2011 commences. In these really busy times, it would be of great help to us if you could ensure that all permission forms are returned promptly; all outstanding accounts are paid; all absence notes are sent to school with your child when he/she re-attends; if book-club orders are returned by the due date with the correct amount of money; if outstanding library books are returned promptly; and if you search through the pile of lost property for clothing items which may be missing from your child's wardrobe.
