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# And so to the busy end of the year...

We have a team of very interested and enthusiastic mums who are currently working with the school in a voluntary capacity to construct, implement and maintain a school vegetable garden in the area at the end of C Block near the new water tank and the worm and compost farms. I congratulate them on their initiative.

It is planned that the garden will be built by the team during the Christmas holiday period so that it's ready to go into production in term one. In order to raise some funds and enlist support for the project, the garden team will be running a cake stall in conjunction with the P&C barbecue on concert night, 14th December. So, if you don't mind a dig in the dirt and would like to get involved, talk to Melinda, Dee, Bec, Emma, Jen or Sasha. I'm sure they would appreciate your interest.

And while we're talking about getting involved, the P&C committee desperately needs your help in selling raffle tickets at the Clunes Shop and/or the Eltham Pub. I know you're busy (aren't we all ?) but even one hour of your time would help. There are approximately eighty families at this school. If each family contributed one hour of ticket-time, imagine how many raffle tickets could be sold, making a tidy sum for the purchase of resources to benefit your children. So, be generous, contact Caitlin and give a little to gain a lot.

The configuration of classes for 2012 (and allocation of children and teachers) is currently under consideration. We need to take account of all the factors involved (skills, personalities, strengths, needs, relationships, etc) and, as it's extremely important to get the blend right to create optimal learning conditions, the process takes time (Form in haste, repent at...).

Having considered all the fore mentioned characteristics, the decision is then about numbers. Total student enrolment determines the number of teachers appointed to a school and thus, the number of classes which can be formed. The pattern of enrolment numbers (i.e, number of students around ages and stages) determines which classes need to be split; where we can have straight classes; and which combinations of classes will work.

In a small school like ours, accurate enrolment figures for the ensuing year are extremely important, as a difference of one or two students can have a major impact on class formation. If you know of anyone who is considering enrolling students at Clunes in 2012 but has not yet done so, please encourage them to contact us now. Class formation is a big task and we try very hard to get it right. So be patient, the task will be completed soon and everyone will be advised of the outcome before the end of term.
