#### Our final week...

Next week is one of the busiest on the school calendar. It's a week of performance, celebration, socialisation and presentation. On Wednesday night, the annual school concert gets underway. This popular event on the Clunes calendar provides a fitting conclusion to the school music program by showcasing what has been achieved throughout the year. A huge amount of effort goes into the production and, as all students have the chance to be on- stage at some time during the evening, everyone has the opportunity to showcase their talents. It's always a great night out.

The evening commences with a P&C barbecue at 5:00pm. At 6:10pm a bell will ring for all students to go to their classrooms and prepare for the performance. The concert will begin at **6:30pm** (I'm aware that the starting time was initially advertised as 6:00pm, but it's too early for some working parents).

Each year we hold a concert dress rehearsal to which we invite the Clunes Pre-School. The pre-schoolers are always an attentive audience; which is important for our students in their last-chance opportunity to "get it right" before the big night. This year, we are opening up the dress rehearsal to grandparents who may not be able to attend the concert on Wednesday night.

Grandparents who wish to attend (what is essentially a final practice) need to be in the school hall at 11.45am.

On Thursday, the Year 6 dinner and school disco will be held. The dinner, commencing at 5:45pm is for Year 6 students and parents. It will be prepared by parents and served by Year 5 student helpers. No other students are to be on the school site at that time. The school disco, for students enrolled at Clunes School only, commences at 7:00pm. Entry is by gold coin donation. No intending disco dancer is to be on the school site prior to this time.

Yesterday, Senior Constable Presgrave addressed the Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 students about Cybersafety. An information session for parents is planned for Monday evening at 6:00pm. Details and a response slip were included in last week's newsletter. To date, we have a very low take-up rate. As I need to know final numbers to determine whether the session will proceed, please advise by 11:00am tomorrow morning if you wish to attend. Some of our Year 6 students missed the session on Wednesday. They are welcome to attend, accompanied by their parents, on Monday evening.
