School Banking Update from Commonwealth Bank

For 90 years, our School Banking program has helped children learn about money, reinforced the importance of regular savings and provided structure for parents to support their children to save.

Though the program continues to have strong support from schools, parents and teachers, recent decisions by some state and territory governments because of a review by the corporate regulator mean we are unable to continue providing programs in schools, and we have had to make a difficult decision to close our School Banking program for all government and non-government schools across the country.

Even though the CommBank School Banking program will not be returning to your school after this year, you can continue to make deposits into your child's Youthsaver account through online transfers or at any CommBank branch. Clunes OSHC

This week, the children of Clunes OSHC have been experimenting in all kinds of ways. We have been experimenting with colour, creating marbled pictures using the technique of hydro dipping. This is where you spray paint to float on water then dip paint in over the top to make a marbled pattern. We only used three colours, but the effect was quite spectacular. We tested the strength of magnets, using them to add attachments on the play equipment then jumped and shook to try and get them off. Some children created

shapes and towers and tested the magnets' ability to keep the shape while rolling it down the slide.







Lastly, we trialled another edible slime recipe. We hypothesized how the slime would look, taste and feel. This slime was made with jelly and glucose syrup. Some children thought the slime would be too sweet while others thought it would feel like playdough. It took a little while for the slime to set but when it did it was sticky and a little too hard. Maybe next time we will get the consistency we want.
